MEMORANDUM FOR United States Army, Promotion Work Centers

SUBJECT: HQDA Promotion Point Cutoff Scores for 1 May 2024 and Semi-Centralized Reminders and General Information for the Active Army

1. **Reference(s):** Army Regulation (AR) 600-8-19, Enlisted Promotions and Demotions - Published on 26 October 2023, effective date 26 November 2023 (Click <u>HERE</u>).

2. Work Analysis and Integration.

- a. **Purpose:** To reinforce current procedures concerning the above subject.
- b. Function: Enlisted Promotions and Reductions.

c. **Task:** Process monthly Headquarters, Department of the Army (HQDA) promotion point cutoff scores and enlisted promotion information.

3. Eligible Soldiers who meet the following criteria may appear before a promotion board between 10 March 2024 through 26 March 2024 as follows:

a. To Staff Sergeant (SSG) must complete Distributed Leader Course (DLC) 2 prior to board appearance. In accordance with (IAW) AR 600-8-19, paragraph 1-34 a (3).

b. To SSG **primary** zone: Sergeant (SGT) with minimum 70 months' time in service (TIS) and 16 month's time in grade (TIG).

c. To SSG **secondary** zone: SGT with minimum 46 months TIS and 6 months TIG.

d. To SGT must complete DLC 1 prior to board appearance, IAW AR 600-8-19, paragraph 1-34 a (1).

e. To SGT **primary** zone: Corporal (CPL) /Specialist (SPC) with minimum 34 months TIS and 10 months TIG.

f. To SGT **secondary** zone: CPL/SPC with minimum 16 months TIS and 4 months TIG.

g. Soldiers must meet all eligibility criteria IAW AR 600-8-19, Table 3-1.

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4. Soldiers (including Soldiers currently in the rank of SGT under the provisions of Mandatory List Integration (MLI)) who are otherwise eligible, held recommended list status and have all supporting data entered into the systems of record as of 26 March 2024 who meet or exceed the cutoff score as they appear beginning on page 6, and the criteria listed below, may be promoted effective 1 May 2024 as follows:

a. To SSG must graduate the Advanced Leader Course (ALC) before they are eligible for consideration for promotion pin-on to SSG, IAW AR 600-8-19, paragraph 1-34 a (4).

b. To SSG primary zone: SGT with minimum 72 months TIS and 18 months TIG.

c. To SSG **secondary** zone: SGT with minimum 48 months TIS and 8 months TIG.

d. To SSG MLI: SGT with minimum 84 months TIS and 24 months TIG.

e. To SGT must graduate the Basic Leader Course (BLC) before they are eligible for consideration for promotion pin-on to SGT, IAW AR 600-8-19, paragraph 1-34 a (2).

f. To SGT **primary** zone: CPL/SPC with minimum 36 months TIS and 12 months TIG.

g. To SGT **secondary** zone: CPL/SPC with minimum 18 months TIS and 6 months TIG.

h. Soldiers must meet all eligibility criteria IAW AR 600-8-19, Paragraph 5-5, a.

5. Soldiers without asterisks are graduates of BLC for promotion to SGT and ALC for promotion to SSG. Soldiers with two asterisks are temporary promotions without the completion of required Professional Military Education.

6. **SPC Waiver Information**: The Directorate of Military Personnel Management (DMPM), Army G1 has announced the variable SPC waiver ceiling percentage is 25%, IAW AR 600-8-19, paragraph 2-3 a (3).

REMINDERS/GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. Weapon Qualification – Expiration Dates Enforced. Effective with 01 May 2024 promotion month, Soldiers will lose promotion points under their Weapon Qualification, if date is greater than policy cited within AR 600-8-19, Paragraph 3-15, Sub-Paragraph a, (2). Qualification scores exceeding 24 months will not be awarded promotion points. The loss of these promotion points will NOT be grounds to seek an Administrative System Corrections (ASC) – Reference: AR 600-8-19, Paragraph 3-23. 2. HRC Junior Enlisted Promotions (JEP) – Job Aids / Information Papers. In an effort to provide the field guidance related to current trends and corrective actions, HRC JEP has published several job aids / information papers. A central page has been posted to the Mil.Suite web forum, S1 Net (Click <u>HERE</u>).

3. Temporary Promotion to Promote Soldiers without Requisite Professional Military Education (PME) Refer to Memorandum HQDA (DAPE-ZA), Subject: Reinforcement of Select, Train, Educate, Promote (STEP) Policy for Noncommissioned Officer (NCO) Promotions and Limited Application of Temporary Promotions, dated 14 December 2023, the reinforcement of STEP policy is suspended until further notice. The previously announced limited application of temporary promotions is suspended until further notice. The Army will apply temporary promotions to all Soldiers who are unable to attend a requisite level of professional military education to qualify for promotion to all noncommissioned officer (NCO) ranks as authorized in AR 600-8-19, Paragraph 1-35. 4. **AR 600-8-19**, Enlisted Promotions and Reductions - An updated version of AR 600-8-19 is available via the APD internet web address cited below. This updated version is dated **26 October 2023** with an effective date of **26 November 2023**. To obtain a copy click <u>HERE</u>.

5. HRC Junior Enlisted Promotions / Posted Enlisted Promotion Informational Slide Presentation, as of 12 April 2024. 6. HR SUPERVISORS GRANTED ACCESS / APPROVAL OF PROMOTION CONSIDERATION

ROSTERS (PCRs) – On / about 12 August 2023, the access role within the Integrated Personnel and Pay System - Army (IPPS-A) was expanded to include the role permission to approve integrations of Soldiers on the PCR. Logic behind this expanded role was linked to legacy integrations resided with this same authority (*unit S1s integrated Soldiers onto the Promotion Recommended List prior to IPPS-A*). The HR Supervisor's will still use approved board proceedings as a source document for integrations. Reference: AR 600-8-19, Figure 3-1, Figure 3-2, and Figure 3-3.

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7. INTEGRATIONS NO LATER THAN 26TH DAY OF THE MONTH - GREENWICH MEAN TIME -

Integrations must be done no later than the 26th day of the month with the understanding IPPS-A operates on Greenwich Mean Time (*not the same as Eastern, Central, or Pacific Standard Time*). Unit S1s should be aware of the Greenwich Mean Time **date / time stamp** and plan accordingly when integrating Soldiers.

8. ASC / ARC Difference Within Integrated Personnel and Pay System – Army (IPPS-A) -

Commanders / First Sergeants / Unit Human Resource Professionals, should be aware of the provisions outlined MILPER Message 22-436, Paragraph 10, in which the field was advised of the Administrative Records Corrections (ARC) had a name change now called Administrative System Corrections (ASC). Requests for backdated promotions are now called Administrative System Corrections (ASC). The new version of AR 600-8-19, Paragraph 3-23, reflects this name change. Unit S1s are reminded ARC request submitted via IPPS-A are not pay impacting request and do **NOT** result in the publication of a promotion orders. Refer to MILPER Message 22-436 for additional information (click <u>HERE</u>).

9. **MILPER Message 23-178,** Commanders / First Sergeants / Unit Human Resource Professionals, should be aware of the provisions outlined within this MILPER Message related to the Soldier Referral Program (SRP). The line of effort for processing early promotions related to the SRP was updated from unit S1s to the US Army Human Resources Command. Unit S1s should refrain from submitting IPPS-A – Special Promotion PARs on this specific Special Promotion. US Army Human Resources Command will initiate, process, and approve all qualified Soldiers via the USAREC consolidated validation roster. Refer to MILPER Message 23-178 for additional information (click <u>HERE</u>).

10. **MILPER Message 23-022 expired 26 October 2023; superseded with release of AR 600-8-19 dated 26 October 2023.** Although the MILPER has expired, the contents remain relevant in that Commanders / First Sergeants / Unit Human Resource Professionals, should be aware of the provisions outlined in AR 600-8-19, Paragraph 3-23. Rules for processing administrative systems correction (Regular Army and U.S. Army Reserve (Active Guard Reserve)). This will apply to selections for 1 January 2024 and dates moving forward in time.

11. Weapon Scores into Digital Training Management System (DTMS), dated 03 March 2023, refer to HRC web page by clicking <u>HERE</u>.

12. Monthly Promotion Timelines for Promotions to SGT / SSG. IAW AR 600-8-19, Paragraph 3-3, f, promotion boards will be held from the 10th to the 26th of each month. Records will have to be updated by the 26th of each month for promotion consideration on the first day of the second month. For example, eligibility for 1 May 2024 promotion pin on selection will be as of 31 March 2024, with a requirement to have supporting data entered into systems of record, no later than 26 March 2024.

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13. **Invalid promotion boards -** Promotion boards must be conducted between the 10th through the 26th of the board month. A First Sergeant (E8 or below) as the board president or promotion boards conducted outside of the dates stated will make promotion boards invalid. The Junior Enlisted Promotions section will flag all Soldiers appearing on the promotion board proceedings. See AR 600-8-19, paragraph 3-10, a, composition of promotion boards.

14. **MILPER Messages** – Unit S1, MPD personnel, and Soldiers, should review the following messages: 23-178, 23-260, 23-418, 23-517, 23-518, 23-519, 24-026, 24-114, 24-125, and 24-126.

Soldiers possessing an MOS listed as a STAR MOS are still required to meet or exceed an announced HQDA cutoff score.

12B, 12D, 12P, 12R, 13B, 13F, 13M, 17C, 17E, 19K, 31D, 35L, 35S, 46S, 68F, 68V, 68Y, 88K, 88L, 89A, 89D, 91A, 91M, 91P, 92S, 94P.

SSG

12D, 12M, 12T, 12Y, 13M, 13R, 17C, 17E, 19K, 25D, 37F, 51C, 79R, 89D.

NOTE: Soldiers holding a STAR MOS should be given a high priority for BLC attendance due to increased promotion potential.

The Star Languages for the language dependent MOS 35P **MOS 35P and Language (by LIC)**

SSG: CM, RU

SGT: AZ, CM, KP, RU

NOTE: Soldiers holding a STAR MOS <u>or 35P STAR Language</u> should be given a high priority for BLC attendance due to increased promotion potential.
